Bomar assured the commissioners that they will bring a rental machine at no cost to the county when they come to get the county's new machine for warranty issues. Bomar guaranteed NMC will make it right at no additional cost to the county.

B. Speck, with the BKR Extension office met with the commissioners to present the 2024-2025 budget. After discussion, Frederick moved to approve the BKR Extension budget presented by Speck with the Keya Paha County percentage increase of \$535.00, Nilson seconded. Voting: Tuerk—yes, Frederick—yes and Nilson—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

Discussion was held on the wooden fence along the parking lot, it was decided to remove the fence and replace it with cement curb stops.
