As CBOE Tuerk moved to approve the 2024 consolidated tax levies as follows: MNRD—0.67537, LNRD—0.66621 and the Village—1.12741, Nilson seconded. Voting: Tuerk—yes, Frederick—yes and Nilson—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

The commissioners went to check on the damage at the Norden Tower.
