Chairman Frederick called the meeting to order at 10:00 with Commissioners Nilson and Tiefenthaler and Clerk Wentworth present. Frederick led the pledge of allegiance and referenced the open meetings act posted for the public.

After review Frederick moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as presented, Tiefenthaler seconded. Voting: Nilson—yes, Frederick—yes and Tiefenthaler—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

Tiefenthaler moved to accept the monthly reports for the Treasurer, Clerk and District Court Clerk, Nilson seconded the motion. Voting: Frederick—yes, Tiefenthaler—yes and Nilson—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

Voting: Nilson—yes, Frederick—yes and Tiefenthaler—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried. Frederick moved to authorize Jeff Cook to sign the documentation for the purchase of the pick up, Nilson seconded. Voting: Frederick—yes, Tiefenthaler—yes and Nilson—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

At 3:30 pm the chairman declared the meeting adjourned until the next regularly scheduled meeting to be held on Tuesday, November 25th at the courthouse meeting room.
