Chairman Tiefenthaler called the meeting to order at 10:00 with Commissioners Frederick and Nilson and Clerk Wentworth present. Tiefenthaler led the pledge of allegiance and noted the open meetings act posted for the public.

After review Nilson moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as presented, Frederick seconded. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tiefenthaler—yes and Frederick—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried. Nilson moved to accept the Clerk, District Court Clerk, and Treasurers monthly reports as presented, Tiefenthaler seconded. Voting: Tiefenthaler—yes, Frederick—yes and Nilson—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

Frederick moved to adopt Resolution 26-10, Signing of the County Annual Certification of Program Compliance 2026, and for the Chairman to sign the Annual Certification of Program Compliance to Nebraska Board of Public Roads Classifications and Standards, Tiefenthaler seconded.
